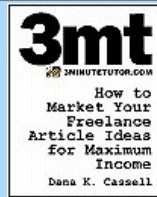
Details on payment: We're a small and relatively new coffeeshop/community space. For performances and readings, we generally charge an entrance fee that varies depending on the act. Usual fee is \$5-10, sliding scale. For smaller, lesser known folks, we would not charge a cover. Our policy is that 30% of entrance fees goes to the artist. Additionally, we encourage the sale of t-shirts, books, cds, etc. Vox Pop policy is that 50% of any profits from these sales goes to Vox Pop, with remainder to artist.

Generally, for writers, we request that the writer provide us with a short story, essay, etc. that we will publish via Instabook, which will be provided to the audience as a part of their entrance fee. We encourage all writers to contact us, and hope to hear from you soon!
